



Sen. Jake Corman Endorses Jim Christiana for U.S. Senate

BELLEFONTE, Pa. (Dec. 18, 2017) -- State Sen. Jake Corman today endorsed state Rep. Jim Christiana for the United States Senate. Christiana, a Republican from southwestern Pennsylvania, announced earlier this year that he will challenge incumbent U.S. Sen. Bob Casey.

Corman called Christiana “the right man to represent Pennsylvania in Washington.” He cited Christiana’s work on a number of legislative issues in the Pennsylvania House of Representatives, particularly in the areas of energy and education.

“I have been impressed with Jim’s efforts and tenacity, fighting for school choice for our children,” Corman said. “He also has an impressive track record in support of the development of Pennsylvania’s energy resources. He championed legislation that resulted in Shell’s decision to build a cracker plant in western Pennsylvania, a project that will add 10,000 new jobs and revitalize the region.”

“Jim worked tirelessly -- and effectively -- to get this game-changing legislation passed,” Corman said. “In Harrisburg Jim Christiana has been a skillful leader with great instincts driven by strong conservative principles. I fully expect that he will prove equally impressive in Washington. I proudly support Jim in his campaign for a seat in the United States Senate.”

Christiana thanked Corman for his endorsement, saying, “Sen. Jake Corman, as Senate majority leader, is a commanding conservative voice in the Pennsylvania General Assembly. I’m honored to have his support.”
